ORDER

The City and County of San Francisco is authorized to construct Alabama Street between Alameda and Sixteenth Streets at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of San Francisco, San Francisco County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. E-1.95-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by three Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry involved contemplates immediate construction and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately.
