ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route 38 (U.S. 40) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Boca, Nevada County, at the locations as shown by maps (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. A-214.2-A and A-216.8-A, respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D. During the period of construction applicant is authorized to create temporary minimum vertical clearances of 20'0" above top of rail and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such temporary impaired clearances provided it issues appropriate bulletins to employees involved advising them of the temporary reduced clearances and forbidding them from riding on the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structures.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
