O R D E R

The County of Humboldt is authorized to construct Fort Seward Road No. P224 and alternate road at grade across tracks of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near Fort Seward, Humboldt County, at the two locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. 5-215.9 and 5-215.8, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than 24 feet. Grades of approach shall be as indicated in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
