Fred L. Matt, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities between:

1. Sacramento, on the one hand, and points on U. S. Highway 99 between Sacramento and Turlock, excluding Sacramento but including Turlock and Elk Grove, on the other hand.
2. Sacramento, on the one hand, and Clarksburg, Isleton, Rio Vista, Oakley, Antioch, Pittsburg, Brentwood, Byron, Courtland, Walnut Grove, Thornton, Oakdale, Riverbank, Locke, Hughson and Escalon, on the other hand.

The authorities set forth in paragraphs 1 and 2 do not include the right to render service to, from or between intermediate points.

Applicant shall not establish through routes and joint rates, charges and classifications as to the separate authorities hereinabove set forth in paragraphs 1 and 2.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
