SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

This Commission in its Decision No. 55500, issued September 3, 1957, in Application No. 38440, directed, by ordering paragraph 4, that Pacific Water Co. "within thirty days after the effective date hereof, *** shall replace with a 4-inch line the 2-inch intake pipe from the existing storage tank in Tract No. 5259 to the booster pump. Applicant shall notify the Commission, in writing, within ten days after such replacement has been completed and placed in operatiop." The purpose of the requirement was to eliminate cavitation in the booster pump when it was in operation.

By applicant's first supplemental application, filed December 18, 1957, and Exhibit "A" attached thereto, the Commission has been advised that prior to November 18, 1957 the subject 2-inch intake line was replaced with a 3-inch intake line and the pressure operating range of the booster pump was increased to the range for which it was designed so that cavitation is no longer present when the booster pump is in operation.

By Decision No. 55500, supra, applicant was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to serve Tract No. 5259 but was not authorized to extend service outside the tract without further order of the Commission.

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Exhibit A attached to the original application delineated Tract No. 5259 and excluded a parcel of land having dimensions 630.63 feet by 963 feet which was surrounded on three sides by the numbered tract. Subsequent to issuance of Decision No. 55500 applicant prepared a customer survey and is now aware that water service is being, and for some time past has been, provided within the above referred to excluded area. Applicant now requests inclusion of this excluded area in the area certificated to it by Decision No. 55500, supra.

The above-entitled supplemental application having been filed, the Commission having considered the matter and being of the opinion that applicant's requests are reasonable and that a public hearing thereon is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 55500, supra, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"That Pacific Water Co. shall forthwith modify the booster pump installation to provide an adequate intake pipe and so that the installation will operate within the design pressure range to prevent cavitation. Applicant shall notify this Commission, in writing, that said modifications have been completed and placed in operation, within ten days thereafter."

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2. That ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 55500, supra, be and it is amended to read as follows:

> "Pacific Water Co., a corporation, be and it is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to acquire, construct and operate a public utility water system in Tract No. 5259 and, in addition, a parcel of land 630.63 feet by 963 feet lying west of Mesa Road, south of Lot 16 and north of Lots 17 and 18, Tract 5259, San Bernardino County."

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In all other respects said Decision No. 55500, supra, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
