O P I N I O N

Howard J. Liggett, applicant herein, requests the Commission to renew his motor transportation broker's license for the year 1958.

Applicant was originally granted a motor transportation broker's license by this Commission on August 27, 1957, by Decision No. 55473. On December 16, 1957, by Decision No. 55978, applicant's original motor transportation broker's license was amended. As amended, this license authorized applicant to arrange for transportation in interstate commerce of unmanufactured agricultural commodities exempt from regulation by Section 203(b)(6) of the Interstate Commerce Act, and also to arrange for transportation in intrastate commerce.

With respect to arranging for transportation in interstate commerce, applicant points out that, because of the numerous carriers used, with few repetitions, the Commission licensed him to arrange for such transportation and immediately notify the Commission in writing of the name of the carrier being used at the time, together with its address. Applicant requests that he be authorized to continue such practice.

Applicant sets forth the fact that he is executive vice president of Reefer Truck Dispatch, Inc., which corporation has joined in his application for renewal of the license.

Applicant also requests that he be authorized to conduct the business of motor transportation broker at 333 North Imperial Avenue, El Centro, Imperial County, in addition to the location previously authorized, to wit: Shed #1, East Gabilan Street, Salinas, Monterey County.

After full consideration of applicant's request, we find no reason to withhold the issuance of the new license applied for. It will be granted under the same terms and conditions as that granted by Decision No. 55473 and amended by Decision No. 55978. Applicant has on file a co-applicant form of surety bond executed by the corporation of Reefer Truck Dispatch, Inc., as principal, as provided for in Section 4838 of the Public Utilities Code.

In our opinion a public hearing is not required in this proceeding and the application will be granted.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a license is hereby granted to Howard J. Liggett to act as a motor transportation broker as defined in Section 4083 of the Public Utilities Code subject to the conditions hereinbelow set forth.

2. That the said licensee shall keep his license certificate as a motor transportation broker posted at his authorized places of business in order that it is readily available to public inspection at all times.

3. That the said licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker at the following locations only, to wit: Shed #1, East Gabilan Street, Salinas, California, and 333 North Imperial Avenue, El Centro, California.

4. That the said license shall authorize licensee to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation over the public highways of this state in intrastate commerce for K. R. Nutting Co., and for such other motor carriers as applicant may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

5. That the said license shall authorize applicant to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation over the public highways of this state in interstate commerce of unmanufactured agricultural commodities, which are exempt from regulation by Section 203(b)(6) of the Interstate Commerce Act and stated in Determination of Exempted Agricultural Commodities, 52 MCC 511, for Pacific Intermountain Express Company, and such other motor carriers for whom applicant may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent Commission order, and all other names which may be included in this order by amendment effected by applicants' stating their names and addresses in one or more letters addressed to this Commission and duly deposited in the United States

mail with appropriate stamp affixed thereto, such mailing to be completed prior to the performance of any transportation arranged by applicant.

6. That the Secretary of the Public Utilities Commission shall issue and deliver to Howard J. Liggett a license certificate as a motor transportation broker in the form heretofore adopted by the Commission for such license certificate and subject to the conditions hereinabove set forth, provided that the names of the motor carriers applicant is authorized to serve need not be set forth therein but in the space provided in said license certificate for such names there shall be stated the following:

"Licensee is authorized only to negotiate for or hold himself out as one who furnishes or provides transportation in interstate or intrastate commerce over the public highways as a motor transportation broker on behalf of the motor carriers now included in the order of the Public Utilities Commission granting this license or subsequently included by amendment."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
