OPINION AND ORDER

Southwest Water Company, a corporation, by application filed December 6, 1957, seeks authority to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement, dated April 30, 1957, with Capri Estates, Inc. and Manhattan Terrace No. 1, Inc. covering the extension of water distribution facilities to serve the subdivision known as Skylark Terrace, Riverside County.

Decision No. 54649, dated March 12, 1957, in Application No. 38576 (Amended), granted the applicant herein a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a public utility water system in certain unincorporated territory in Riverside County. In said decision the Commission noted that the applicant in said proceeding had entered into an agreement, dated October 8, 1956, with certain subdividers, which agreement neither conformed to the sample form of main extension agreement on file with this Commission, nor had been approved by this Commission.

In ordering paragraph 9 of said decision, the applicant was directed to negotiate an agreement with the subdividers which would conform to the appropriate sample form of main extension agreement on file with the Commission and file a copy of such agreement with the Commission. As an alternative, applicant was to request Commission authorization of the agreement dated October 8, 1956, by the filing of a formal application.

On April 30, 1957, applicant entered into a revised agreement with the subdividers. Although this agreement conforms to the appropriate sample form of main extension contract on file with the Commission, the time allowed by Decision No. 54649 for filing such agreement has expired. Applicant now seeks approval of the revised agreement, a copy of which is attached to the instant application as Exhibit A.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southwest Water Company be and it is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the written agreement, dated April 30, 1957, Exhibit A of the

application, with Capri Estates, Inc. and Manhattan Terrace No. 1, Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
