## ORDER MODIFYING PREVIOUS DECISION

By Decision No. 53521, dated July 31, 1956, an interim opinion and order in Case No. 5679, Sunshine Water Company was ordered to provide no service to any new customers or additional subdivisions until the Commission orders otherwise.

Subsequently, Southern California Water Company was authorized, by Decision No. 54881, dated April 22, 1957, in this proceeding, to purchase the water utility properties operated by Sunshine Water Company, and in said decision, Southern California Water Company was ordered to assume the responsibility for compliance with all applicable outstanding orders of the Commission pertaining to the public utility operations of Sunshine Water Company, with particular reference to, but not limited to, Decision No. 53521.

By affidavit filed on October 25, 1957, Southern California Water Company affirms that it has made certain improvements described in Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2 in this proceeding, and that it believes the installation of these improvements has remedied the inadequate and insufficient water service referred to in said Decision No. 53521.

It appearing that there is no longer any need for the restrictions referred to herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that,

1. Decision No. 54881 is modified by relieving Southern California Water Company of the duty of complying with that portion of Decision No. 53521, by which the Commission ordered:

> " (1) That Sunshine Water Company shall provide no service to any new customers or to any additional subdivisions outside of its present service area unless or until otherwise ordered by this Commission."

2. In all other respects, said Decision No. 54881 shall remain in full force and effect.
