Application of the County of Los Angeles for the opening of a highway crossing at Harcourt Street between Artesia Street and Victoria Street, over the Southern Pacific Company railroad drill track, near the town of Dominguez, in the County of Los Angeles.

## ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct
Harcourt Street at grade across a drill track off Southern Pacific
Company's San Pedro Branch, at the location described in the
application, to be identified as Crossing No. BG-495.9-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance
cost cutside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific
Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of
crossing shall be not less than 56 feet and grades of approach
not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or
superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection
shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No.
75-B) with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless

time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,
necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant has indicated that, under its program, other improvements are being deferred until this authority is secured, and has requested a waiver of the usual 20-day clause. The effective date of this order is therefore the date hereof.
