ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Cerritos Avenue, in Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BM-512.9. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a minimum width of 24 feet across both the spur track and the branch track, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served has alleged that need for rail service is acute, and applicant has requested that the 20-day waiting period be waived. The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
