FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 56133, dated January 21, 1958, in the above-numbered application of California Water & Telephone Company, a corporation, to increase rates for water service in its San Gabriel Valley Division, applicant was ordered, as a condition precedent to the authorization to file a new schedule of rates, within ninety days after the effective date of said decision, to submit to the Commission, in writing, a plan for the elimination of lack of water and low pressure conditions in its Euclid area, and to report to the Commission in writing, its progress in connection therewith every thirty days thereafter until such program is completed. Applicant was further advised that when the Commission had been satisfied that such plan had been initiated, the Commission would issue its further order setting the dates upon which the rates authorized might be filed and placed in effect.

By its letter dated February 20, 1958, and by its further letter dated February 24, 1958, applicant submitted its plan required by Decision No. 56133, supra. Applicant indicated that the

service connection to the 16-inch transmission main owned by the City of South Pasadena, as set forth in said letters, would be in operation prior to April 15, 1958, and the Commission has been informed that all other work in connection with alleviating the low pressure conditions complained of in applicant's Euclid area was to be completed by that date.

It appearing that applicant has complied with the conditions precedent to the authorization to file its new schedule of rates, and the Commission being satisfied that the plan to eliminate lack of water and low pressure conditions in applicant's Euclid area constituting such conditions has been initiated,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That California Water & Telephone Company, a corporation, be and it is authorized to file in quadruplicate with this Commission after the effective date of this order, in conformity with the Commission's General Order No. 96, the schedules of rates shown in Appendix A attached to Decision No. 56133, dated January 21, 1958, in the instant application, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public to make such rates effective for service rendered on and after April 1, 1958.

2. That applicant shall report to the Commission in writing, its progress in connection with its plan for the elimination of lack of water and low pressure conditions in its Euclid area, as outlined in its letters to the Commission dated February 20 and 24, 1958,

every thirty days after the effective date hereof until such plan is completed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
