ORDER

County of San Joaquin is authorized to construct Industrial Drive at grade across tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company near Ortega, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 4-90.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-two feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 3 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
