That the operating right heretofore granted to George Pistacchio, Joseph Pistacchio and Frank Montevacchi, by Decision No. 51647, dated July 5, 1955, in Application No. 36648 in so far as it authorizes said applicants to transport property to or from Puente and in so far as it authorizes the transportation of cottonseed between any points in this State, be and it is, suspended to

and including December 31, 1958.
