ORDER OF REVOCATION

Angelo Bonzi, doing business as Service Bus Line, is ✓
authorized to render passenger stage service between Stockton, Linden, ✓
Bellota, Farmington, Escalon, Modesto, Empire and Hughson, and
intermediate points, under authority of certain certificates of
public convenience and necessity heretofore granted by this Commission.

On August 29, 1957 this company discontinued service
between the above-mentioned points and subsequently on October 29,
1957 permitted its public liability and property damage insurance
policy to lapse. Under these circumstances this carrier's certifi-
cate must be revoked.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 43135 dated July 19, 1949 in Application No. 30122 as amended in Decision No. 47653 dated September 2, 1952 in Application No. 33656, and all operating rights owned and possessed by Angelo Bonzi, doing business as Service Bus Line, authorizing passenger stage service between Stockton, Linden, Bellota, Farmington, Escalon, Modesto, Empire and Hughson, and intermediate points, are hereby revoked. All effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of Angelo Bonzi, doing business as Service Bus Line, are hereby revoked and canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Angelo Bonzi in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof unless the above individual before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth therein, and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall hereby be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order issued.
