OPINION AND ORDER

Camino, Placerville and Lake Tahoe Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company have filed this application for an order authorizing Camino, Placerville and Lake Tahoe Railroad Company to sell to Southern Pacific Company, for the sum of \$400, certain real property located in Placerville, as shown in the map attached to the application and as more particularly described in the copy of the quitclaim deed filed as Exhibit A. Applicants assert that the seller no longer needs the property for railroad purposes but that the use of said property is required by the purchaser.

The Commission has given consideration to this application and is of the opinion, and so finds, that the proposed transfer will not be adverse to the public interest and that an ex parte order should be entered granting applicants' request, therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:


1. Camino, Placerville and Lake Tahoe Railroad Company may sell to Southern Pacific Company the real property referred to in this application.


2. The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the property herein authorized to be transferred.


3. The authority herein granted will become effective on the date hereof.
