## $\underline{O P I N I O N}$

By application filed October 17, 1957, Highway Transport Express seeks an order authorizing it to serve as an express corporation all remaining points and places and over all routes that Highway Transport, Inc., is presently authorized to serve as a highway common carrier.

Public hearing was held in San Francisco on December 16, 1957, before Examiner Rowe, at which time evidence was adduced and the matter duly submitted for decision.

From the evidence of record, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require that the requested authority be granted to applicent.

## <u>0 R D E R</u>


Application therefor having been filed, public hearing having been held and the Commission being fully advised and basing its decision upon the above findings.

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Highway Transport Express authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as an express corporation, as defined in

(2) That said operative rights are granted subject to the condition that they may never be transferred separate and apart from said underlying rights.

(3) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
