L. H. Dowe, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport:

1. GENERAL COMMODITIES between:
 - (a) All points and places in Imperial County.
 - (b) The points designated in subparagraph (a), on the one hand, and, on the other hand, Los Angeles Territory as described in Appendix B attached hereto.
2. CEMENT, LIME OR PLASTER, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 21660 through 21750 of Western Classification No. 76, George H. Dumas, Agent, on the issue date thereof, between the points designated in paragraph 1(a), on the one hand, and Riverside, Crestmore and Colton, on the other hand.
3. CONDUITS, DRAIN TILE, SEWER PIPE OR RELATED ARTICLES, CLAY, CONCRETE OR EARTHEN, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 28980 through 29210 of Western Classification No. 76, George H. Dumas, Agent, on the issue date thereof, between the points designated in paragraph 1(a), on the one hand, and Corona, on the other hand.
4. COTTON, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 31130, 31170, 31190 through 31260 of Western Classification No. 76, George H. Dumas, Agent, on the issue date thereof, between the points designated in paragraph 1(a), on the one hand, and Blythe and points within 25 miles of Blythe, Coachella and Hinkley, all on the other hand.

Appendix A

L. H. DOWE

The authorities hereinabove set forth in paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 do not include the right to render service to, from or between intermediate points.

Applicant shall not establish through routes and joint rates, charges and classifications as to the separate authorities hereinabove set forth in paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.

6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
