## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Winans Bros. Trucking Co., a corporation, operates as a highway common carrier of lumber and forest products. By prior orders in this proceeding, petitioner and its predecessors, Frank C. and Grant A. Winans, copartners, doing business as Winans Brothers, have been authorized to publish a rate lower than the established minimum rate for the transportation of cedar pencil stock from Anderson (Shasta County) and points within four miles thereof to San Leandro. The published rate of 35 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 40,000 pounds, expires April 1, 1958.

By Sixth Supplemental Petition, permission is requested to continue to maintain the 35-cont rate for a further one-year period. Data submitted with the supplemental petition shows that the volume of traffic has increased, and that the operations have been profitable and may reasonably be expected to continue to be profitable during the ensuing year.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rate is reasonable and justified by transportation

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conditions. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The Sixth Supplemental Petition will be granted. In view of the expiration date of the current authority, the order will be made effective on the date hereof, and the tariff filing will be authorized to be made on not less than two days' notice.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Winans Bros. Trucking Co., a corporation, is hereby authorized, on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public, to publish and file a rate of 35 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 40,000 pounds, to expire April 1, 1959, for the transportation of cedar pencil stock from Anderson, and points within four miles thereof, to San Leandro.
