ORDER DENYING REHEARING

Decision No. 54669 was issued on March 12, 1957. Petitions for rehearing were denied on June 18, 1957. The decision became effective on that date. No petition for writ of review was filed, and the decision became final, so far as review is concerned, on July 19, 1957. (Public Utilities Code, sec. 1756.)

In December of 1957 several petitions were filed requesting a reopening of the proceedings for further hearings, and seeking to have the final order of March 12, 1957 suspended and vacated. The petitions were set for hearing. Thereafter, on March 11, 1958, the requested reopening was denied by Decision No. 56333.

Petition for rehearing has been filed by Alameda-Contra Costa

Transit District, City and County of San Francisco, Thousand Oaks
Improvement Association, Claremont Improvement Club, Inc., and
Kensington Improvement Club. The Commission having considered said
petition, and each of the allegations thereof, and being of the
opinion that no good cause has been shown for the granting of
rehearing, IT IS ORDERED that said petition for rehearing is hereby
denied.
