O R D E R

The County of Monterey is authorized to widen and reconstruct the crossing of Espinosa Road at grade with track of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. E-111.5), near Castroville, Monterey County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach shall be as indicated in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by the existing Standard No. 3 wigwag signal and Standard No. 1 crossing sign, (General Order No. 75-B), relocated to conform to the widened roadway.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
