EIGHTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 56293 of March 3, 1958, in this proceeding, authorized applicants to continue to publish certain reduced rates for the transportation of canned foodstuffs from Hemet to destinations within the Los Angeles Basin Territory. The Commission's attention has been called to an erroneous maximum weight contained in Appendix "A" to the decision. An appropriate correction will be made. A public hearing is not necessary. In order to effect this correction as soon as possible the order will be made effective immediately and applicants will be authorized to amend their tariff on two days' notice.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Decision No. 56293 of March 3, 1958, in this proceeding, is hereby amended by changing the column heading in Appendix "A" thereof, reading "Minimum 18,000 Pounds Maximum 22,000 Pounds" to read "Minimum 18,000 pounds Maximum 23,000 Pounds".


(2) That applicants are hereby authorized to publish in their tariffs, on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the changed weight provisions authorized by paragraph (1) hereof.


(3) That in all other respects the said Decision No. 56293 shall remain in full force and effect.


