

**ORIGINAL**Decision No. 56489

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of TANNER MOTOR TOURS, LTD., for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation in the transportation of persons between Los Angeles, Hollywood, Santa Monica, Beverly Hills, Pasadena, Glendale, Long Beach, and Disneyland Territories and North Hollywood, Studio City, Van Nuys, and Burbank, on the one hand, and, on the other, the Los Angeles Coliseum and Exposition Park in the City of Los Angeles.

By this application, as amended, applicant seeks authority to establish and operate a passenger stage service between various described territories and cities in the Los Angeles basin, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles Coliseum and Exposition Park, on the other hand. The proposed service is on a round-trip basis with no intermediate points of pickup and discharge.

The fares, to which a federal transportation tax would be added, are as follows:

Between Los Angeles Coliseum and Exposition Park

All trips would be subject to a minimum of 20 fares.

Applicant has described several routes between the Coliseum and the various territories proposed to be served which appear to be the most appropriate and direct routes for the particular service. It is proposed to use de-luxe type equipment, and points of pickup and discharge would be at principal motels, hotels, restaurants, or other convenient spots within the said territories and cities. No passengers would be picked up or discharged en route nor would any one-way fares be sold.

Applicant states that the Los Angeles Coliseum is a focal point for important events and that there is a great demand and a public need for the type of transportation service as herein proposed.

The application is not opposed.

The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service as hereinafter set forth. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it hereby is granted to Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of persons between

the points and places, and along the routes as more specifically described in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:

(a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 93. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 93, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

(b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, amendments to its tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.

Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport persons between the Los Angeles, Hollywood, Santa Monica, Beverly Hills, Pasadena, Glendale, Long Beach, Disneyland, North Hollywood-Van Nuys, and Burbank Territories, as hereinafter described, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles Coliseum and Exposition Park, on the other hand, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The transportation service herein authorized shall be rendered only on a round-trip basis and no passenger shall be picked up or discharged at points or places intermediate of the described territory and the Coliseum or Exposition Park.
- (b) Applicant shall pick up and discharge passengers only at points and places to be named in applicant's tariff and situated within the territories and cities hereinbelow described.
- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify said passenger stage operation at any time, applicant shall conduct said operation over and along the most direct or appropriate route or routes, subject, however, to local traffic rules.

- (d) The territories within which applicant is authorized to name pickup and discharge points are described as follows:

Los Angeles Territory

Beginning at Olympic Boulevard and Los Angeles Street; northerly along Los Angeles Street to Macy Street, including therein the Los Angeles Union Depot; westerly along Macy Street and Sunset Boulevard to Figueroa Street; southerly along Figueroa Street to Third Street; westerly along Third Street to Bixel Street; southerly along Bixel Street to Sixth Street; westerly along Sixth Street to Ardmore Avenue; southerly along Ardmore Avenue to Eighth Street; easterly along Eighth Street to Catalina Street; northerly along Catalina Street to Seventh Street; easterly along Seventh Street to Figueroa Street; southerly along Figueroa Street to Olympic Boulevard; easterly along Olympic Boulevard to point of beginning.

Hollywood Territory

Beginning at Sunset Boulevard and La Brea Avenue, southerly along La Brea Avenue to Santa Monica Boulevard; easterly along Santa Monica Boulevard to Gower Street; southerly along Gower Street to Melrose Avenue; easterly along Melrose Avenue to Van Ness Avenue; northerly along Van Ness Avenue to Sunset Boulevard; easterly along Sunset Boulevard to Western Avenue; northerly along Western Avenue to Franklin Avenue; westerly along Franklin Avenue to La Brea Avenue; southerly along La Brea Avenue to point of beginning; and, also, including points on and along Sunset Boulevard from the corner of Sunset Boulevard and La Brea Avenue to La Cienega Boulevard.

Santa Monica Territory

All points in Santa Monica within the area bounded by Washington Avenue, Stanford Street and Lipton Avenue, Centinela Avenue, Olympic Boulevard, Centinela Avenue, Pico Boulevard and First Street.

Beverly Hills Territory

All points in Beverly Hills within the area bounded by Sunset Boulevard, Rexford Drive, Olympic Boulevard and the western boundary of the City of Beverly Hills.

Pasadena Territory

All territory within the city limits of the City of Pasadena.

Glendale Territory

All territory within the city limits of the City of Glendale.

Long Beach Territory

All territory within the city limits of the City of Long Beach.

Disneyland Territory

Beginning at the intersection of Ball Road and Euclid Avenue; thence along Euclid Avenue to the Santa Ana Freeway; southeasterly along the Santa Ana Freeway to Katella Avenue; westerly along Katella Avenue to Harbor Boulevard; southerly along Harbor Boulevard to Orange Wood Avenue; westerly along Orange Wood Avenue to Euclid Avenue; northerly along Euclid Avenue to point of beginning.

North Hollywood-Van Nuys Territory

Beginning at Sepulveda Boulevard and Ventura Boulevard; northerly along Sepulveda Boulevard to Sherman Way; easterly along Sherman Way to Vineland Avenue; southerly along Vineland Avenue and Lankershim Boulevard to Ventura Boulevard; westerly along Ventura Boulevard to point of beginning.

Burbank Territory

All territory within the city limits of the City of Burbank.
