O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works is authorized to construct State Route 3 (U.S. 99-E) "Yuba River Bridge and Overhead" at separated grades over the relocated spur track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company at Marysville, Yuba County, at the location as shown by maps (Exhibits B and C) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-179.21. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order #26-D. Upon completion of "Yuba River Bridge and Overhead", Crossing No. 4-179.3-C located approximately 0.1 mile easterly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
