## ORDER

County of Lassen is authorized to construct Forest Highway Route 92 at grade across a track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company near Norvell, Lassen County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 4K-55.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety

so require. Applicant desires to advertise for construction bids at the earliest possible date and requests immediate authorization. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
