## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

This Commission's Decision No. 52930 issued April 24, 1956, in Application No. 37797 authorized Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company to carry out the terms of an agreement dated January 26, 1956, wherein Pacific agreed to supply Edison power up to 75,000 kilowatts, together with such energy required therewith, from January 21, 1956 to March 20, 1958.

On February 4, 1958, Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company entered into a supplemental letter agreement whereby the aforementioned existing agreement between Pacific and Edison is amended so as to extend the time period thereof from March 20, 1958 to June 30, 1958, subject to the election of Edison to terminate the extension on an earlier date upon giving Pacific written notice of such election not less than 10 days in advance of the termination date. In all other respects the provisions of the A. 37797 (1st Suppl.) ds

agreement dated January 26, 1956 are to remain in full force and effect. A copy of the letter agreement marked Exhibit B is attached to the application.

The Commission having considered the request of applicants and being of the opinion that the supplemental letter agreement dated February 4, 1958, is not adverse to the public interest and that the application should be granted, and being of the further opinion that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company be and they are authorized to carry out the terms of said supplemental letter agreement dated February 4, 1958.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants shall file a statement with this Commission promptly after termination of this supplemental agreement showing the date when said agreement was terminated.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
