O P I N I O N

Key System Transit Lines requests authority to make changes in five of its local lines in the East Bay.

The proposed rerouting of Routes Nos. 14A, 18, 44, 46 and 88 would conform with proposed transbay bus routes to be established soon and would also conform to the City of Oakland's one-way street program involving 12th and 13th Streets east of Market Street.

After consideration of the application the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premise,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines, a corporation, authorizing the transportation of passengers as a passenger stage corporation over and along the following streets:

32nd Street between Adeline and Peralta Streets,  
Peralta Street between 32nd and 36th Streets,  
Market Street between 12th Street and 13th Street,  
Franklin Street between 12th and 13th Streets.

(2) That applicant may discontinue service over the following streets:

Oak Street between 12th and 11th Streets,  
Madison Street between 14th and 13th Streets.

(3) That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
