ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 52735 and Decision No. 54528, George Seals was authorized to conduct a passenger stage service between Los Angeles and the Long Beach Naval Shipyard.

George Seals has advised the Commission that due to lack of patronage he has been forced to discontinue operations and therefore requests cancellation of his certificates.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the certificates of public convenience and necessity created by Decision No. 52735 in Application No. 37577 and Decision No. 54528 in Application No. 38643 are revoked and all effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of George Seals are cancelled.

(2) The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon George Seals in the manner prescribed by law.

(3) The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
