ORDER OF REVOCATION

Asphalt Service Co., a corporation, was authorized to acquire a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a petroleum irregular route service between all points in California from La Verne S. Castle by the Commission's Decision No. 50005 in Application No. 35321. The Commission originally issued this certificate to Castle by Decision No. 44625 in Application No. 31147.

The Commission has been advised in writing that operations under these rights heretofore have been discontinued and that Asphalt Service Co. is no longer engaged in the trucking business. Asphalt Service Co. now requests that such certificate be cancelled and revoked.

In view of the foregoing, the Commission finds that the operations described above have been discontinued and abandoned without appropriate authority having first been obtained therefor.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity created by Decision No. 44625 dated August 8, 1950 in Application No. 31147 and transferred to Asphalt Service Co. by Decision No. 50005, dated May 5, 1954, in Application No. 35321 is

revoked and all effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of Asphalt Service Co. are cancelled.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Asphalt Service Co. in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service unless Asphalt Service Co., before the effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein, and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall thereby be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
