SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 55544, James A. Stafford was ordered, among other things, to take appropriate action or measures to collect the belance of applicable charges as set forth in said decision and in the event charges to be collected and payments to be made as provided in said order remained uncollected or unpaid ninety days after the effective date of said order (September 30, 1957), James A. Stafford was required to submit to the Commission on Monday of each week thereafter a report setting forth the action taken to collect said charges and the result of such action until the charges and payments were collected in full or until further order of this Commission.

The Commission's records disclose of the total undercharges of \$295.26, respondent Stafford has collected \$75.62 and the balance has been billed to various shippers who to date have not paid.

Respondent proposes to take legal action if necessary.

Petitioner asks that he be relieved of the necessity of making weekly reports to the Commission because such requirement is time consuming and expensive and places an undue burden upon him. As respondent has consulted his attorney for the purpose of collecting said charges, a weekly report is not deemed necessary.

IT IS CRDERED that paragraph (2) of the Order in Decision No. 55544 on Case No. 5916 be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

(2) That James A. Stafford shall take appropriate action or measures to collect the balance of the applicable charges as above set forth and in the event charges to be collected and payments to be made as provided in this order remain uncollected or unpaid ninety days after the effective date of this order, James A. Stafford shall submit to the Commission on the first Monday of each month a report setting forth the action taken to collect said charges and the result of such action until such charges and payments have been collected and paid in full or until the further order of this Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
