Application of the County of Los Angeles for a grade crossing on Arrow Highway over the Pacific Electric Railway line between Amclia Avenue and Eucla Avenue, near the town of San Dimas.

ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Arrow Highway at grade across the San Dimas spur track off the Pacific Electric Railway Company's San Bernardino Line near the town of San Dimas, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-26.05-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 80 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
