## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 56574, dated April 22, 1958, in this proceeding, the Commission, upon request, revoked the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Asphalt Service Co., a corporation, to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier. It has been brought to the Commission's attention that the first ordering paragraph in connection with the cancellation of tariffs on file in the name of Asphalt Service Co., a corporation, needs further clarification. IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 56574 of April 22, 1958, in this proceeding, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity created by Decision No. 44625, dated August 8, 1950, in Application No. 31147 and transferred to Asphalt Service Co., a corporation, by Decision No. 50005, dated May 5, 1954, in Application No. 35321 is hereby revoked.
- (2) That Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, W. J. Knoell, Issuing Officer, is authorized and directed to cancel, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the participation of Asphalt Service Co. from its tariffs on file with this Commission.

(3) That Power of Attorney AF 1 No. 2 issued by Asphalt Service Co. in favor of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby canceled.

In all other respects Decision No. 56574 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the same as Decision No. 56574.
