## ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 39974 dated February 15, 1947, in this proceeding, Francis Lazia, doing business as Petaluma-Tomales-Fallon Truck Line, was authorized to acquire from Guy Jameson a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier of property between Petaluma, Tomales, Fallon, Valley Ford and Eloomfield and intermediate points.

Francis Lazia does not have on file evidence of liability insurance as required by General Order No. 100-A. A Commission staff investigation developed that he has performed no for-hire carrier operations since February, 1958; that he has not applied for 1958 licensing of his equipment; that he does not intend to resume operations under his certificate; and that he has no objection to the Commission revoking his certificate.

It appears that the common carrier operative right here involved has been abandoned. Therefore, the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued in this proceeding will be revoked and all effective tariffs on file with the Commission in the name of Francis Lazia will be canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and nocessity granted Francis Lazia by Decision No. 39974 dated February 15, 1947, in this proceeding, is revoked and that all effective tariffs and powers of attorney on file with the Commission in the name of Francis Lazia are canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Francis Lazia in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Francis Lazia unless he, before such effective date, shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall hereby be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
