ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct Redding Avenue at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AH-94.3-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-eight feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

An additional set of flashing lights facing Redding Avenue shall be installed on the northwest flashing light signal standard at Crossing No. AH-94.3, 65th Street.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
