Application of the State of California, )  
 Department of Public Works, for an order )  
 authorizing construction of two crossings )  
 at grade, the abandonment of four cross- )  
 ings at grade and the realignment of ) Application No. 39080  
 6500 feet of Southern Pacific Company's )  
 track, in connection with the improvement )  
 of State Route IV-Nap-49-B, sometimes )  
 referred to as "Yountville Line Change". )

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is author-  
 ized to relocate California Drive and to construct Madison Street at  
 grade across the relocated track of Southern Pacific Company near  
 Yountville, Napa County, at the locations described in the applica-  
 tion to be identified as Crossings Nos. AB-77.8 and AB-78.65,  
 respectively.

Expense of construction, maintenance and elimination shall  
 be borne in accordance with agreements now being entered into between  
 the parties involved and copy of said agreements shall be filed with  
 the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the  
 parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion such costs by  
 subsequent order. Width of crossings shall be not less than twenty-  
 four feet and grades of approach not greater than shown on Exhibit  
 "D" of the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to  
 Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at Crossing  
 No. AB-77.8 shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General  
 Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflectorized "STOP ON RED SIGNAL" signs  
 and at Crossing No. AB-78.65 shall be by two Standard No. 1A crossing  
 signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon completion, two private grade crossings located approx-  
 imately at Mileposts 78.7 and 78.8 shall be physically closed by

Southern Pacific Company through the construction of proper barriers in such manner as effectively to prevent the use thereof by vehicular traffic. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
