O R D E R

The City of San Jose is authorized to widen and reconstruct the crossing of Almaden Road at grade with track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, Crossing No. 4G-20.3, in the City of San Jose, Santa Clara County, as described in the application and substantially in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be as indicated in the application. Grades of approach shall be not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by five Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. (General Order No. 75-B)

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended, or if the above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
