Decision No. 56794

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of SAN DIEGO TRANSIT SYSTEM, a corporation, for authority to reroute its Route "G" - DOWNTOWN SAN DIEGO-CONVAIR ASTRONAUTICS line, and its Route "J" - OCEAN BEACH-CONVAIR ASTRONAUTICS line.

O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 56322, on Application No. 39735, applicant recently was authorized to establish and operate several routes to the new Convair Astronautics Plant in San Diego. Two of said routes were Routes "G" and "J" as described on Original Page 11A and Original Page 12A of Appendix A to said decision.

Applicant now requests a partial rerouting of said two routes, and as justification alleges that the present Route "G" provides for two-way operation on 5th Avenue between Beech Street and Broadway; that 5th Avenue is a one-way street northbound south of Beech Street; that an error was inadvertently made in Application No. 39735; that the proposed rerouting southbound via Beech Street and 4th Avenue to Broadway conforms to the routing of applicant's other routes which operate southbound on 5th Avenue.

It also appears that passengers from the Cabrillo Heights (north) portion of applicant's Route "H" will want to transfer to Route "G" for transportation to the Astronautics Plant. Under

the present routing the only point for such a transfer would be at Aero Drive and U. S. Highway 395. No facilities for such a stop are available on U. S. Highway 395, nor would they be permitted. The proposed rerouting would provide a satisfactory transfer point between Routes "H" and "G" at Kearny Villa Road and Aero Drive, and would provide an improved service to the public.

Certain industrial and commercial development is presently being constructed on the west side of Kearny Mesa Road north of Aero Drive. The proposed rerouting of Route "J" would serve this area, and in addition would avoid a traffic bottleneck on Aero Drive between Linda Vista Road and Kearny Villa Road caused by cars destined for the Astronautics Plant turning from Linda Vista Road to go north either on Kearny Villa Road or U. S. Highway 395.

There is no material change in mileage. Applicant's request is not opposed and appears to be in the public interest. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and finding that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Transit System, a corporation, may reroute the following lines:

Route "G" - Downtown San Diego-Convair Astronautics
Route "J" - Ocean Beach-Convair Astronautics

and Appendix A to Decision No. 55090^{1/} is hereby further amended by

1/ Decision No. 55090, dated June 4, 1957, is the current basic in lieu certificate of San Diego Transit System and, as subsequently amended, contains the descriptions of applicant's routes.
