In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a drill track across Fillmore Street, between Thermal and Mecca, in the County of Riverside, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Fillmore Street, near the town of Thermal, Riverside County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-619.0-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a minimum width of 24 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served has indicated an urgent need for rail service for transportation of perishable fruit products now in season and requests a waiver of the usual twenty-day waiting clause. The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
