Applicant will charge a fare of approximately \$7 per passenger for the trip which involves about one hundred miles and the service will be rendered only when requested by at least six passengers. From the information furnished in the application, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the proposed service is required by public convenience and necessity; that applicant has sufficient equipment and financial ability and that he is sufficiently experienced to be able to properly and successfully perform this operation. This service will not compete with any other passenger stage corporation. A public hearing is unnecessary. The Hearst Castle will be open on June 2, 1958. Consequently, the effective date of this decision will be one day after the date hereof. 1
