O R D E R

City of Sacramento is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AU-93.1-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not greater than six feet and grades of approach shall be not greater than as shown on the plan entitled Exhibit "A" attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). A turnstile shall be installed and maintained at expense of applicant at each railroad right-of-way line.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,
or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be
twenty days after the date hereof.
