Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Upon completion, the private crossing about 30 feet south shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. -1-
