## OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. <u>50591</u>, entered today, we found that the transportation of property by carriers engaged exclusively in an expedited special messenger service should be exempted from the minimum rates, rules and regulations named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (only within the Los Angeles Basin Territory) and in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 should be amended by separate order.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective August 1, 1958, Twenty-Sixth Revised Page 15, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
