O P I N I O N

Pursuant to ordering paragraph 6 of Decision No. 50908, Pacific Motor Trucking Company requests a new certificate restating its operative rights as a highway common carrier.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Thomas E. Daly on May 23, 1958, at San Francisco. No appearance was made in protest to the authority sought.

By reason of the acquisition of the operative rights of Pacific Freight Lines, numerous paralleling and duplicating operative rights have resulted. The restatement of applicant's operative rights in loose-leaf form will do away with such duplications, as well as inconsistencies in lateral authority. It will also eliminate many varying conditions with respect to commodities, points and areas served.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of property, except uncrated household goods and other related commodities for which the Commission has prescribed minimum rates in City Carriers' Tariff No. 3-A, Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 4-A, to, from and between all points and over the routes as described and specified in Appendix A which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, subject to the limitations and conditions therein specified.

2. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of petroleum products, in bulk, except liquefied petroleum gases and any other petroleum products requiring pressurized tanks and except liquid asphalt and hot road oils and any other petroleum products requiring insulated tanks, to, from and between all points and over the routes as described and specified in Appendix B which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a petroleum irregular route carrier, as defined in Section 214 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products, within areas described and specified in Appendix C which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, subject to the limitations and conditions therein specified.

4. That the certificates of public convenience and necessity granted in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this order are not in addition to but are certificates de novo in lieu of all existing operative rights now held by Pacific Motor Trucking Company, and all certificated authority heretofore held by applicant is hereby revoked.

5. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 99. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 99, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

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SECTION I - GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Consolidation

The rights and routes of operation herein authorized, and each thereof, are hereby consolidated each with the other so that the same shall constitute a single unified operation, subject only to any exceptions or conditions applicable thereto hereinafter expressly set forth.

2. Direction of Route Description

When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply equally to operations in the reverse direction unless the service authorized is specifically limited to transportation in one direction only.

3. Regular Routes

Except as otherwise stated in connection with a specific route description, all routes herein authorized are designated as "regular routes". "Regular routes" are defined as those which are to be served in accordance with published tariffs of the carrier filed with the Commission in accordance with its rules and regulations appertaining thereto.

4. Alternate Routes

Routes hereinafter designated as "alternate routes" are routes which are in addition to the authorized regular routes between the named termini and are authorized for operating convenience at the option of the carrier, with no service being rendered at intermediate points along such routes unless expressly so authorized.

5. Highway Designations

When a route of authorized operation is described herein by U. S. Highway number, the route intended is the one bearing such number as of the date of authorization:

When a route of authorized operation is described herein by California Highway number, the number refers to that established by the State of California Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, sometimes referred to as "State Highway Sign Number", and the route intended is the one bearing such number as of the date of authorization.

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SECTION I - GENERAL CONDITIONS - CONTD.

6. Regular Route Operations

Service is authorized to, from, or between all termini specified. Service to, from, or between intermediate points or in a lateral territory or zone is authorized as specifically set forth under each regular route.

7. Lateral Operations

Except as otherwise stated in connection with a specific route description, all service authorized in a lateral territory or zone in conjunction with a regular route includes the right to render service to, from, or between all points and places within the prescribed area.

From Contra Costa-Alameda County Line over California Highway 17 to Contra Costa-Marin County Line.

Service is authorized at all intermediate points.

7.5 Between Hercules and Contra Costa-San Joaquin County Line:
