ORDER OF REVOCATION

Harold K. Hopkinson has authority from this Commission to render service as a passenger stage corporation between Lake Gregory and Crestline, California, during the period of June 15 and October 1 each year, and between those points and the Valley of Enchantment during the same portion of the year.

The certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate buses between these points were acquired in Decision No. 45976, dated July 24, 1951, in Application No. 32434, and in Decision No. 47777, dated September 30, 1952, in Application No. 32434, 1st Supplemental. On September 9, 1957, Harold K. Hopkinson permitted his public liability and property damage insurance to lapse. By letter dated May 12, 1958, Harold K. Hopkinson advised that passenger stage service has been discontinued and that he has no intention of resuming this service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 45976, dated July 24, 1951, in Application No. 32434 and in Decision No. 47777, dated September 30, 1952, in Application No. 32434, 1st Supplemental, authorizing passenger stage service between Lake Gregory and Crestline, California, and between those points and the Valley of Enchantment, are hereby revoked. All effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Harold K. Hopkinson are hereby revoked and cancelled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served on Harold K. Hopkinson in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
