<u>OPINION</u>

Gibson Lines, a corporation, requests authority to suspend its passenger stage service to and from Beale Air Force Base, near 1/Marysville, for one additional year. As justification, applicant alleges that it has reason to believe that Camp Beale will be activated within one year. Prior to such reactivation, a maintenance force of about 100 men is being retained there. They have no substantial need for public transportation.

After full consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity will be subserved by granting applicant's request. A public hearing appears unnecessary.

ORDER

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That Gibson Lines, a corporation, is authorized to continue suspension of passenger stage service to and from Beale Air Force Base until July 1, 1959.
- 2. That applicant shall post an appropriate notice of this additional suspension of operations, as herein authorized, at its Marysville and Sacramento stations for a minimum of five days next preceding said suspension of operations.

3. That, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall file appropriate tariffs and time-tables in triplicate reflecting the authority herein granted which tariffs and timetables shall be satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this decision shall be ten days after the date hereof.
