SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

This Commission's Decision No. 46461 dated November 27, 1951, in Application No. 32791, authorized Southern California Edison Company and San Diego Gas & Electric Company to carry out the terms of an agreement dated August 22, 1951, for the interchange between the systems of said companies of economy energy and emergency generating capacity and emergency energy. By a supplemental letter agreement dated July 6, 1956 Edison and San Diego agreed to extend from August 21, 1956 to August 21, 1958, the period during which they would interchange electric energy and generating capacity. Authority to carry out the terms of said supplemental letter agreement was granted in Decision No. 53734 dated September 4, 1956.

On May 5, 1958, Southern California Edison Company and San Diego Gas & Electric Company entered into a second supplemental letter agreement whereby the period during which Edison and San Diego would interchange electric energy and generating capacity would be further extended from August 21, 1958 to August 21, 1966. In all other respects the provisions of the agreement dated August 22, 1951 would remain in full force and effect. A copy of the letter agreement marked Exhibit A is attached to the application.

The Commission having considered the request of applicants and being of the opinion that the supplemental letter of agreement dated May 5, 1958 is not adverse to the public interest and that the application should be granted, and being of the further opinion that a public hearing is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company and San Diego Gas & Electric Company be and they are authorized to carry out the terms of said supplemental letter agreement dated May 5, 1958.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants shall file a statement with this Commission promptly after termination of this supplemental agreement, showing the date when said agreement was terminated.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
