OPINION

American Buslines, Inc., requests authority to abandon service to and from Camp Stoneman.

Because Camp Stoneman was deactivated applicant was authorized by Decision No. 54456, to suspend service for a period of one year. The temporary suspension has expired and applicant asserts that after making inquiries there is no evidence that the camp will be reactivated in the foreseeable future.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service to and from Camp Stoneman. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the operative rights granted by Decision No. 39214, dated July 9, 1946, in Application No. 27386 and by Decision No. 46718 dated February 5, 1952, in Application No. 32904 are hereby revoked.
- 2. That applicant shall amend its tariffs and timetables presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority

herein granted.
