ORDER OF REVOCATION

Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop doing business as Motor Street Car Service have authority from this Commission to render service as a passenger stage corporation within the City of Santa Rosa and its environs. On June 15, 1958, Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop permitted their public liability and property damage insurance to lapse. By letter dated June 11, 1958, Chris Badenhop (partner) advised that passenger stage service would be discontinued in the City of Santa Rosa and environs at 6 p.m., June 13, 1958.

An investigation discloses that said passenger stage service has been discontinued, and that Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop have no intention of resuming this service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 56347, dated March 11, 1958, in Application No. 39686 authorizing passenger stage service within the City of Santa Rosa and environs is hereby revoked. All effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Chris Badenhop and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop are hereby revoked and cancelled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served on Chris Badenhop

and Mabel Dorothy Badenhop in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
