#### FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds highway contract carrier, radial highway common and city carrier permits. Prior orders in this proceeding have authorized him, as a city carrier under Section 4015 of the Public Utilities Code, to charge less than the established minimum rates for the transportation of flour for ten flour companies within the City and County of San Francisco.<sup>1</sup> The authority expired on December 20, 1957.

By this supplemental application, as amended, authority again is sought to transport flour for the aforementioned companies at rates lower than the minimum. The rates now proposed are higher than those previously authorized.

The supplemental application states that, except for increased labor costs, the conditions which justified the original deviation from the minimum rates still obtain and that the proposed increased rates will offset these higher labor costs. The application shows that the operations herein involved have been conducted at a profit under the previously authorized rates and that, at the rates now proposed, the operations may reasonably be expected to be

The companies are: Monarch Flour Company, Fisher Flour Mills, Centennial Flour Mills, Cook Flour Company, Coast-Dakota Flour Company, General Mills, Terminal Flour Mills, Northwest Flour Mills, Blue and Gold Sales Service and Pillsbury Mills. A. 35575(4th Supp.)-JC

### profitable for the future.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rates are reasonable and consistent with the public interest. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The supplemental application, as amended, will be granted. However, as the conditions surrounding the transportation may change, the authority will be limited to one year, unless sconer canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Bruno Malucchi, doing business as A. M. Devincenzi Company, operating as a city carrier, is hereby authorized to transport flour for Monarch Flour Company, Fisher Flour Mills, Centennial Flour Mills, Cook Flour Company, Coast-Dakota Flour Company, General Mills, Terminal Flour Mills, Northwest Flour Mills, Blue and Gold Sales Service and Pillsbury Mills from their established places of business in San Francisco to points and places within the city limits of San Francisco, at rates less than the minimum rates but not less than those set forth in Appendix "A" hereof.

(2) That the authority herein granted shall expire August 1, 1959, unless sconer canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
