OPINION AND ORDER

In this application, The California Oregon Power Company seeks authorization to sell certain warehouse and storage site properties located in Klamath Falls, Oregon, to Klamath Ice and Storage Company.

Applicant is a California corporation which is engaged in the public utility business in both California and Oregon. The properties it now desires to sell presently are used in its public utility operations and, although they are located in Oregon, applicant has filed this application out of an abundance of caution in order to obtain this Commission's approval should it be found that such approval is required.

The Commission has considered this matter and will enter an order granting applicant's request; NOW THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:

1. The California Oregon Power Company may issue and sell the real property and improvements referred to in this application.

2. The authorization herein granted shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of said real property and improvements.

3. On or before September 30, 1958, applicant shall advise the Commission in writing of the action taken by it under the authorization herein granted.

4. This Opinion and Order is effective upon the date hereof.
