O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across State Highway Route 5 (Oakland Highway) and Berryessa Road near San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. DA-45.29-C and Crossing No. DA-46.1-C, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the roads now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.  
Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,  
necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days  
after the date hereof.
